

## **Storm Preparation Checklist**

☐ Discuss the type of hazards that could impact your family. Know your
home's vulnerability to storm surge, flooding and wind.
☐ Locate a safe room or the safest areas in your home for each hurricane
hazard. In certain circumstances the safest areas may not be your home but within your community.
☐ Have an out-of-state friend as a family contact, so all your family
members have a single point of contact.
☐ Make a plan now for what to do with your pets if you need to evacuate.
(Shelters and most hotels will not allow pets.)
☐ Stock non-perishable emergency supplies and a disaster supply kit.
• Kit should contain the following:
<ul> <li>□ Water (At least 1 gallon daily per person for 3-7 days)</li> <li>□ Food (At least enough for 3-7 days)</li> </ul>
□ Blankets/Pillows
☐ Clothing (Seasonal/rain gear/sturdy shoes)
☐ First Aid Kit/Medicines/Prescription Drugs
☐ Flashlight/batteries
☐ Radio (Battery operated and NOAA weather radio)
☐ Cash (Banks and ATMs may not be available for awhile)
□ Keys
☐ Important documents (In a waterproof container –
insurance policies, medical records, bank account numbers,
Social Security card, etc)
□ Tools (Keep a set with you during the storm)
□ Vehicle tanks filled.
□ Pet care items (Food, water, proper identification and
leash)
