



## Storm Preparation Checklist

First, make sure you write down your Alfa agent's name, phone number and address:

- Discuss the type of hazards that could impact your family. Know your home's vulnerability to storm surge, flooding and wind.
- Locate a safe room or the safest areas in your home for each hurricane hazard. In certain circumstances the safest areas may not be your home but within your community.
- Have an out-of-state friend as a family contact, so all your family members have a single point of contact.
- Make a plan now for what to do with your pets if you need to evacuate. (Shelters and most hotels will not allow pets.)
- Stock non-perishable emergency supplies and a disaster supply kit.
  - Kit should contain the following:
    - Water (At least 1 gallon daily per person for 3-7 days)
    - Food (At least enough for 3-7 days)
    - Blankets/Pillows
    - Clothing (Seasonal/rain gear/sturdy shoes)
    - First Aid Kit/Medicines/Prescription Drugs
    - Flashlight/batteries
    - Radio (Battery operated and NOAA weather radio)
    - Cash (Banks and ATMs may not be available for awhile)
    - Keys
    - Important documents (In a waterproof container – insurance policies, medical records, bank account numbers, Social Security card, etc...)
    - Tools (Keep a set with you during the storm)
    - Vehicle tanks filled.
    - Pet care items (Food, water, proper identification and leash)
